

German Marshall Islands (1889-1916)

The easternmost island group in Micronesia, consisting of two roughly parallel chains of coral-capped islets and atolls in the western Pacific. Spain sold the Caroline Islands in 1898 to Germany, which renamed them the Marshall Islands and issued stamps for use there. The islands were seized by the Japanese during World War I and administered by them under a 1919. On May 1, 1981, the Marshall Islands received its own constitution. Stamps appeared that October, but these originated privately in Japan. The Marshall Islands began issuing its own stamps in May 1984. The Marshall Islands became fully independent in 1991.


