

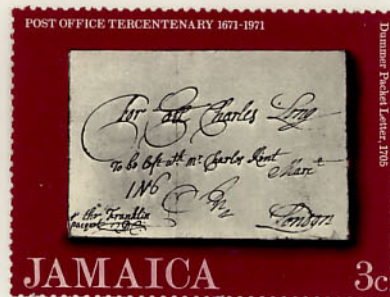
British Jamaica

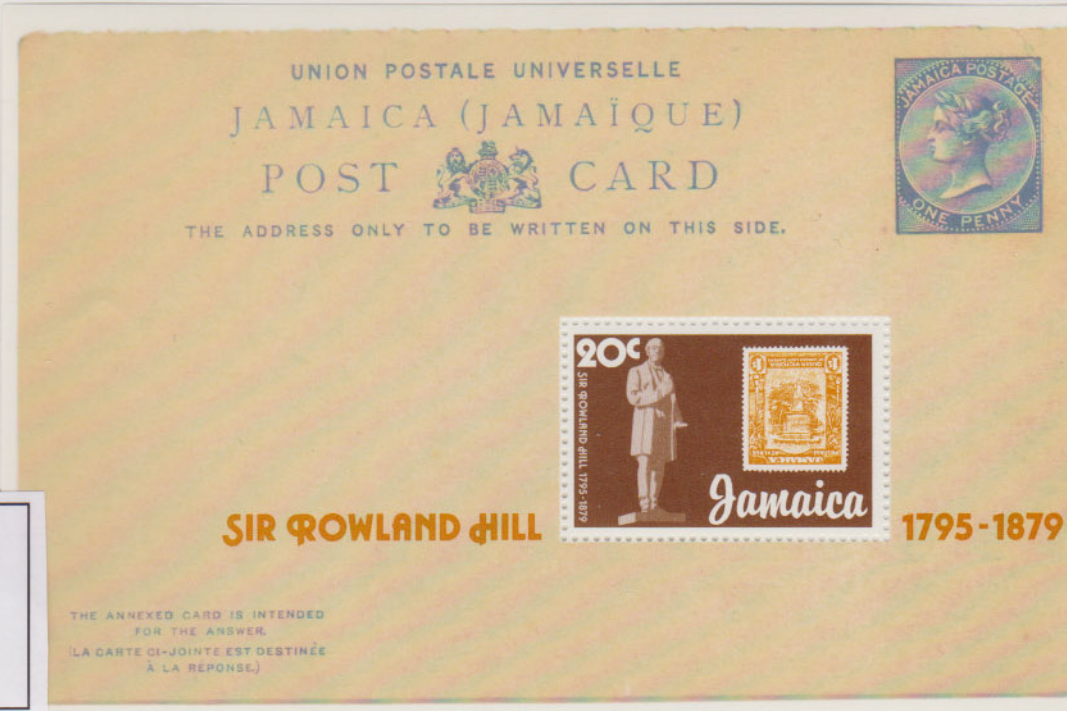
