

Canal Zone (Panama)

(1904-)

The Panamanian government conceded to the U.S. a 10-mile-wide strip of land bisecting the isthmus. Construction of the Panama Canal began the following year and was completed in 1914. During 1964-77, U.S.-Panamanian relations deteriorated over the status of the Canal, which became an emotionally charged issue throughout Latin America. In 1978 a revised Canal treaty was ratified by the U.S. Senate. Implemented in 1979, this treaty provides for the gradual transfer of authority, with full Panamanian ownership by December 31, 1999. Panama assumed political sovereignty in the Canal Zone on Oct. 1, 1979.
